

Fat Quarter Path Quilt

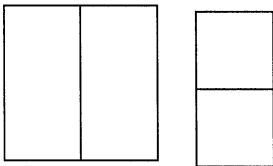
The finish size of the quilt will be 36 x 54 (lap size)
or 52 x 70 with a border.
(The whole quilt is made using 3 ½ inch strips).

Fabric

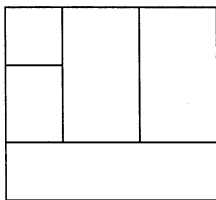
- 6 to 8 fat quarters,
 - Or 1 ½ to 2 yards of assorted fabrics,
 - Or 30 – 3 ½ x 22 inch strips of assorted fabrics
- ½ yard for the binding
- ¾ yard for a border (optional)
- Batting the size of your quilt plus 4inches on both the width and length (i.e. for the small quilt 56 inches by 74 inches piece of batting).
- Fabric for the back, the size of your quilt plus 4inches on both the width and length (i.e. for the small quilt 56 inches by 74inches piece of batting).

INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut 30 3 ½ inch strips
- Take two different strips; with right sides together sew along one edge. Make ten sets.
- Out of each set, cut two 6 ½ inch piece and two 3 ½ inch piece.
- Sew one 3 ½ inch piece to a 6 ½ inch piece. Make twenty sets.



- Sew a 3 ½ inch x 9 ½ inch strip to each set.



- Arrange the block into a 4 x 5 quilt and sew together.
